

# Poker Etiquette



**POKER ETIQUETTE RELATES TO THE MANNER IN WHICH A PLAYER CONDUCTS THEMSELVES. A PLAYER WHO REPEATEDLY VIOLATES POKER ETIQUETTE IS A DISRUPTION TO THE GAME WILL BE WARNED AND GIVEN PENALTIES WHERE NECESSARY.**

**By participating in any Marconi Poker Palace event, you agree to adhere to all MPP rules and regulations and behave in an appropriate manner.**

## **GENERAL ETIQUETTE**

- Be polite.
- Be modest when you win.
- Do not swear or be verbally abusive.
- English only to be spoken at the table.
- Always act in turn. Do not bet, call or fold until it is your turn.
- Always protect your hand. It is your responsibility to ensure your cards are live.
- Show one, show all. If you show your hand to one player you are required to show it to everyone at the table.
- Show your hand in order. The player who originally bet shows first. It goes in turn from there to the last player who called.
- Refrain from criticizing another player's play.
- Keep your chips stacked on the table and in clear view to other players.
- Do not handle another player's chips or cards.
- Keep your cards on the table.
- Do not go through the folded/mucked cards at any time during the hand or after the showdown.
- Never disclose any information that may affect another player.
- Avoid excessive talking, especially across the table. Chit chat is fine, but letting your conversation interrupt the game is disrespectful to everyone at the table
- Keep food and beverages off the table.
- Avoid throwing, marking, bending, or crumpling cards.
- Avoid Destroying or defacing property.
- No spectators allowed in the playing area. Players pit only.

MPP will attempt to maintain a pleasant environment for all our players and employees, but is not responsible for the conduct of any player. We have established a code of conduct, and may deny the use of our card room to violators.
